REGARDING CORONAVIRUS [COVID-19]
*UPDATED APRIL 22 2020***



With the increasing spread of the Coronavirus around the globe, we are very aware that the recent attention around COVID-19 is of concern to people. Come to Jesus Church is committed to the wellbeing of all people within our church community, aiming to provide a safe environment for all who attend our services and programs.

We have considered the recommendations from the Australian Government and Department of Health and are sharing the cautionary measures we will put in place to minimise any potential risk to our CTJ family.

A directive came from our government and health officials advising that we should cease public gatherings. However, our church services **“can be streamed or recorded as long as only the person/s conducting the service and the person/s involved in enabling it to be streamed or recorded are present.”** We want to be a people of faith, but also exercise wisdom stewarding people and keep them safe, particularly those who are more vulnerable at this time. For this reason, we will be moving to online services until further notice.

We want to continue to be a church that Connects, Cultivates and Commissioning people into His harvest. There is a lot of fear and uncertainties around this time, but we have the Light to bring hope in our nation! We now have an excellent opportunity to be the church for such a time as this. Therefore, we encourage you to continually invite people to tune in to our online service every Sunday and stay connected during this time of uncertainty.
